OUR MAIN EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT HAS DESIGNATED AREAS FOR ISOLATING NON-COVID FROM COVID+ PATIENTS, INCLUDING THOSE PATIENTS WHO EXHIBIT FLU-LIKE SYMPTOMS.

- Personal protective equipment (PPE) for staff and patients
- Temperature checks on arrival for both staff and patients
- Prompt identification and isolation of patients with possible COVID-19
- Sanitization efforts 24/7
- Social distancing guidelines in waiting rooms
- Separate areas/elevators for COVID-19 or high risk patients
- Designated care areas for patients with contagious illnesses
- Fast track department

OUR FAST TRACK DEPARTMENT IS DESIGNATED FOR COVID-FREE PATIENTS AND ABLE TO TREAT PATIENTS WITH MANY INJURIES AND ILLNESSES, SUCH AS, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- Lacerations, minor burns, suture removal, bug bites and animal bites.
- Allergic reactions and asthma.
- Ear infections and/or sinus infections.
- Minor falls, sprains, and broken bones.
- Pregnancy testing, STI testing, vaccinations.
- Pediatric care.

NYCH has designated a separate department specifically to house COVID+ patients, as well as, a dedicated elevator to be used only for COVID+ patients.

All other areas of the hospital are non-COVID.
